MIRACLE BABY BEATS ALL ODDS WITH HEART TRANSPLANT

A Family's Journey

As the McDaniel family busily prepared for the arrival of their twins, they had no idea that their lives would be turned upside down once their adorable baby girls were born. Born on July 20, 2012 at the Tahlequah City Hospital, Leah arrived first, weighing 5.6 pounds, with Abigail delivered shortly thereafter, weighing 5.1 pounds. New parents, Amanda and Jimmie McDaniel, along with their 10-year-old daughter Katie, were ecstatic that the blessed day had arrived, but nothing could have prepared the family for the long road that lay ahead when they learned that baby Leah had severe medical issues.

Baby Abigail was in fine health, but doctors determined that Leah required specialized medical treatment immediately. On the evening of her birth, Leah was flown by Life Flight to The Children's Hospital at Saint Francis in Tulsa. Jimmie McDaniel was able to accompany his newborn daughter on the flight, and although Amanda had just undergone a C-section, she and daughter Katie, along with newborn Abigail, were able to arrive in Tulsa three days later in order for the family to be together throughout this frightening time. Their journey had just begun.

The team of specialists diagnosed Leah with hypoplastic left heart syndrome, a rare type of congenital heart disease where parts of the left side of the heart are not fully developed. If left undetected or untreated, the condition is fatal.

For the next 2½ months, The Tulsa Ronald McDonald House became home to Jimmie, Amanda, Katie and baby Abigail as Leah's life hung in the balance. Leah underwent eight surgeries during their stay at the Tulsa House before it was determined that her only chance of survival would be a heart transplant. She had actually died

each morning and leaving around 7:00 each evening for a quick dinner before returning to the House for some much needed rest and comfort. The whole family remained a united front in the hospital room with big sister Katie working on her home-school assignments and entertaining herself with art and crafts projects, while twin Abigail

would eat and sleep next to her sister so their bond would not be disrupted. "We could not have made it if Abigail wasn't such a good baby," stated Amanda. "She has been a real trooper – the perfect baby – and Katie is the best big sister." Amanda continued.

Their journey then took them to St. Louis on September 29, 2012 to anxiously await her heart transplant. Told that it could take 6–10 weeks or more before finding a suitable heart for Leah, the McDaniels' prayers were answered when a short 14 days later, Leah had a heart

match. "It was a miracle. We felt like we had just won the lottery," stated Mr. McDaniel.

The St. Louis Park Avenue Ronald McDonald House became their home-away-from-home for their six-week stay during the successful heart transplant and recuperation period, before returning to the Tulsa Ronald McDonald House for another 3-week stay, while Leah continued her in-patient treatment at The Children's Hospital at Saint Francis. Then the big day arrived – December 4, 2012 – when Leah was strong enough to go home for the very first time. It would be a great homecoming for the entire

twice – once when she went into cardiac arrest following a procedure and once on the operating table – but the doctors never gave up on her and were able to bring her back each time.

Each setback was heart wrenching, but the McDaniels' unwavering faith brought them through each ordeal. "We just kept praying, our pastor and church family at First Apostolic Church in Welling, Oklahoma, kept praying, the doctors prayed before each surgery and we believe it was the Lord that touched them to perform the surgeries," Amanda continued.

The McDaniels kept constant vigil over their daughter, arriving at 6:00

McDaniel family as they began to see the light at the end of the tunnel.

The McDaniels family made such an impression on everyone they met that the Tulsa community, as well as their hometown community of Tahlequah, opened their hearts and their checkbooks to help ease the tremendous financial strain placed upon this family facing such hardships. The nurses at The Children's Hospital at Saint Francis collected \$1,100 in donations, as well as providing numerous gift cards for their use before leaving for St. Louis; their home church – First Apostolic Church – held a community-wide fundraiser in Tahlequah, raising over \$14,000 with nearly 100% participation by every business in the area; and before they returned from St. Louis, a Leah McDaniel Fund was established, raising over \$4,600 in one night after being publicized in the Northeastern State University newspaper. Their final surprise was when KTUL-TV Channel 8's Chief Meteorologist Jennifer Zeppelin arrived at the Tulsa House on Leah's release date, presenting the family with \$500 from an anonymous viewer who had heard of their plight and personally showed up at the studio with this gift for their Random Acts of Kindness program.

The McDaniels are a remarkable family and are so thankful to have stayed at Ronald McDonald Houses throughout their journey. They became everyone's heroes during their stays, exhibiting such grace, faith and perseverance during the most stressful time in their lives, serving as an inspiration to everyone whose lives they touched. They felt blessed with the outpouring of love from family, friends and the Ronald McDonald House family, as well as the support from doctors, nurses, medical support staff and complete strangers. "No one

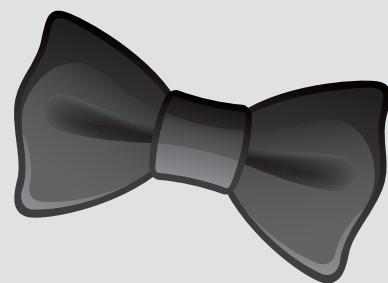

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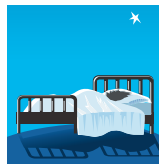
